# CHARLES MIX COUNTY Board of Commissioners Regular Session – January 27, 2022

The Charles Mix County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session on Thursday the 27<sup>th</sup> of January 2022 at 10:00 am. Chairman Nick Stotz opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and called the meeting to order, with Commissioner Keith Mushitz, and Auditor Jason Gant present, and Vice Chairman Colin Soukup attending via teleconference.

## Agenda:
