CHARLES MIX COUNTY Board of Commissioners Regular Session – April 23, 2024

The Charles Mix County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session at the County Courthouse on Tuesday, April 23, 2024, in the Commission Room. Chairman Keith Mushitz called the meeting to order at 11:00 am with Vice Chairman Colin Soukup, Commissioner Nick Stotz, State's Attorney Steve Cotton, Deputy State's Attorney Craig Parkhurst, and Auditor Jason Gant present.

Agenda:

A motion by Stotz and second by Soukup to approve the agenda. All in favor, motion carried.

Minutes:

A motion by Soukup and second by Stotz to approve the minutes from the April 9, 2024, Board of Commissioners regular meeting. All in favor, motion carried.

Bills:

A motion by Soukup and second by Stotz to approve the bills for April 23, 2024. All in favor, motion carried.

Plats:

A motion by Stotz and second by Soukup to approve the PLAT of Lot 1 of Tract A Doom's Addition in Government Lot 4, in the NW1/4 of Section 5, T95N, R63W of the 5th P.M., Lawrence Township near 393rd Ave and 297th St, Charles Mix County, South Dakota. All in favor, motion carried.

A motion by Soukup and second by Stotz to approve the PLAT of Mills Addition, in the NW1/4 of Section 24, T98N, R65W of the 5th P.M., Moore Township near 385th Ave and 282nd St, Charles Mix County, South Dakota. All in favor, motion carried.

Yankton Sioux Tribe Veterans Affairs:

The bridge naming and adopting of highways would be similar to the State of South Dakota DOT programs. More research and information will be gathered.

Assessor Office and Personnel:

Director of Equalization Denise Weber visited with the Commission regarding staffing levels for this summer and the need to hire two additional part time employees.

Superintendent Doug Cimpl updated the Commission on Highway Department operations.

Extra-Territorial Jurisdiction (ETJ):

State's Attorney Cotton and Deputy State's Attorney Parkhurst overviewed possible actions that the Commission could take on the future of ETJ's in the County. City representatives from Platte, Geddes, Lake Andes, Pickstown, and Wagner attended the discussion as well as representatives from District III. Discussion was held on the advantages and disadvantages of implementing an ETJ. No action taken.

Reconvene:

A motion was made by Soukup and seconded by Stotz to reconvene the meeting at 12:23 pm. All in favor, motion carried.

SD Department of Ag and Natural Resources:

A motion was made by Stotz and seconded by Soukup to approve the SD Department of Ag and Natural Resources permit renewal application for the construction and demolition debris disposal facility and for Auditor Gant to sign. All in favor, motion carried.

SD Department of Health:

A motion was made by Soukup and seconded by Stotz to approve the contract for SD Department of Health Community Health Services and for Auditor Gant to sign online. All in favor, motion carried.

SD State Treasurer:

A motion was made by Stotz and seconded by Soukup to authorize Auditor Gant to act on behalf of Charles Mix County to sign the claim form for Unclaimed Property with the SD State Treasurer's office. All in favor, motion carried.

Auditor Update:

Auditor Gant reviewed with the Commission that Initiative Measure petitions were received on April 22nd and will be on the agenda during the May 9th meeting, ES&S Protecting Voting Systems, Communities That Care future presentation, participation in the SD Retirement system, White Lake Rd needing gravel, Employee Handbook update, and the new side by side purchased by the Weed Department. No action taken.

The next Commission meetings are at 10:00 am on Thursday, May 9th at the Courthouse and on Thursday, May 23rd at the Courthouse.
