CHARLES MIX COUNTY Board of Commissioners Regular Session – March 27, 2025

The Charles Mix County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session at the County Courthouse on Thursday, March 27, 2025, in the Commission Room. Chairman Colin Soukup opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and called the meeting to order at 10:00 am with Vice Chairman Nick Stotz, Commissioner Kory Standy, State's Attorney Steve Cotton, and Auditor Jason Gant present.

Agenda:

A motion by Stotz and second by Standy to approve the agenda. All in favor, motion carried.

Minutes:

A motion by Stotz and second by Standy to approve the minutes from the March 13, 2025, Board of Commissioners regular meeting. All in favor, motion carried.

Bills:

A motion by Stotz and second by Standy to approve the bills for March 27, 2025. All in favor, motion carried.
