CHARLES MIX COUNTY Board of Commissioners Regular Session – June 26, 2025

The Charles Mix County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session at the County Courthouse on Thursday, June 26, 2025, in the Commission Room. Chairman Colin Soukup called the meeting to order at 10:00 am with Vice Chairman Nick Stotz, Commissioner Kory Standy, State's Attorney Steve Cotton, and Auditor Jason Gant present.

Agenda:

A motion by Stotz and second by Standy to approve the agenda. All in favor, motion carried.

Minutes:

A motion by Stotz and second by Standy to approve the minutes from the June 12, 2025, Board of Commissioners regular meeting. All in favor, motion carried.

Bills:

A motion by Stotz and second by Standy to approve the bills for June 26, 2025. All in favor, motion carried.

Drainage Hearing:

The Public Hearing was opened with no protest present.

A motion by Standy and second by Stotz to approve Drainage Permit 2025-04 of Ringling Grain Co – Ryan Ringling for the NE 1/4 of Section 12, Township 99N, Range 68W Platte Township, near the intersection of 368th Avenue and 274th Street, Charles Mix County, South Dakota. All in favor, motion carried.

Temporary Alcoholic Beverage Hearing:

The Public Hearing was opened with no protest present.

A motion by Stotz and second by Standy to approve the Temporary Alcoholic Beverage Permit #2025-02 from the Dante Fire Department for the Dante Tractor and Truck Pull to be held approximately 1 mile East of Dante near 401st Ave and 300th St on August 17, 2025. All in favor, motion carried.

Highway Department:

Superintendent Doug Cimpl discussed gravel crushing starting in July at the Starr Varilek gravel pit, traffic counters to be set up this summer, Platte Creek Road, and additional reports regarding Carroll and Castalia unorganized Townships. No action taken.

A motion by Stotz and second by Soukup to approve Chuck Eitemiller's request to install a culvert near 290th St and 392nd Ave in the County's right of way at his expense. All in favor, motion carried.

Veterans Service Officer:

Further discussion on pay, duties, hours, costs, website and drafting a Memorandum of Understanding between the two Counties. No action taken.

Auditor Update:




Next Meetings:
