CHARLES MIX COUNTY Board of Commissioners Regular Session – September 2, 2025

The Charles Mix County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session at the County Courthouse in Lake Andes on Tuesday, September 2, 2025, in the Commission Room. Chairman Colin Soukup opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and called the meeting to order at 10:00 am with Vice Chairman Nick Stotz, Commissioner Kory Standy, State's Attorney Steve Cotton, and Auditor Jason Gant present.

Agenda:

A motion by Standy and second by Stotz to approve the agenda. All in favor, motion carried.

Minutes:

A motion by Stotz and second by Standy to approve the minutes from the August 28, 2025, Board of Commissioners regular meeting. All in favor, motion carried.

Plats:

A motion by Soukup and second by Stotz to approve the PLAT of Aaron's Addition in the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 1, T96N, R66W of the 5th P.M., White Swan Township near 379th Ave and 291st St, Charles Mix County, South Dakota. All in favor, motion carried.
