That on the 16th day of Nov 1910 pursuant to your order and notice we met at the place of said proposed road or public Highway and having first been duly sworn to faithfully perform our duties, with the assistance of a surveyor, proceeded to examine said proposed road or public Highway. Said road or public highway by course and distance is as follows. A strip of land 33 ft wide each side of center line described as follows Beginning at the SW corner of Sec 12 Twp 98 Rge 65 on the county line between Douglas and Charles Mix Counties, thence North 67° west along county line between Lots 3-4 - of Sec 11 Twp 98 Rge 65 in Douglas Co S. D. and Lot 7 Sec 13 Twp 98 Rge 65 in Chas Mix Co S. D. 33⁰⁷ chains to the intersection of section line between sections 11 and 14 Twp 98 Rge 65 in Chas Mix Co. S. D. with above said county line We hereby recommend said road be established as heretofore described
