The following Resolutions were presented to the Board by a delegation of Charles Mix County citizens.

Lake Andis, S.D. Nov. 13, 1918.

Whereas, A delegation of Representative citizens of Charles Mix County appeared before the County Commissioners at this time with a request that the Board make an appropriation of \$35,500.00 for the United War Work Campaign as approved by the War Department of the United States, and,

Whereas, The enlarged war program of the Government of the United States has rendered it necessary that the sum of money to carry forward the work of the several approved societies united in the War Work Campaign be increased fifty per cent and such increase has been duly approved by the War Department of the United States and the apportionment of Charles Mix County including such increase has been fixed at \$35,500.00, therefore,

Resolved, that there is hereby pledged and appropriated from the general fund of Charles Mix County, South Dakota the sum of \$5,500.00 in aid of such United War Work Campaign which said sum shall be paid by county warrant, December 2nd, 1918 and the said Board of County Commissioners further undertake and agree that they will appropriate from the County funds of Charles Mix County the further sum of \$30,000.00 in aid of such United War Work as follows: the sum of \$10,000.00 in January 1919; the sum of \$10,000.00 July 1st 1919, and the sum of \$10,000.00 Oct. 1st, 1919.

Resolved further that the States attorney be directed to transmit to the Attorney General all the facts with respect to the power and authority of the Board of County Commissioners to make the appropriation above mentioned in the manner above provided for and in the event that the Attorney General fails in his opinion to approve of the power and authority of said Board in making such appropriation in such manner, then this resolution to stand revoked, otherwise to be and remain in full force and effect.

These policies are taken out ^{approved} for five years, expiring Nov., 1923.

Mrs. N. L. Miller came before the Board in behalf of the Red Cross Chapter of Lake Andes and asked to have a telephone put into the Red Cross work room in Court House basement. The request was granted.

As there appears to be an error in the amount of money on hand in Lone Tree School Dist., reported by the school treasurer in July 1918 when division of Lone Tree Twp. into 4 school districts was made; the Co. Supt. of Schools obtained an order from the State Attorney to correct this error, approved by the Board. Commissioners Proceedings dated Aug. 13th, 1918 shows balance in the Treasury to be \$1855.⁸⁸ and this was ordered equally divided among the four Districts. The correct amount as reported to Co. Supt. is \$1753.18. Therefore the Co. Supt. by special permission divided this amount equally among the 4 districts. This action was approved by the Board Dec. 3rd, 1918.

The following action was taken by the Board in regard to transferring and dividing money between school districts:

The County Auditor is hereby ordered to transfer the balance ^{which is} of 92 cts in Plain Center Sch. Dist. fund to Rainia Consolidated Sch. Dist. fund as Plain Center now is part of Rainia Consolidated Sch. Dist. The Co. Auditor is also ordered to transfer the balance of \$92.91 in Howard Bond & Interest fund to the several school districts of Howard Twp. The same to be equally divided among said districts.

It is also ordered that the balance of \$226.48 in Highland Bond & Interest fund be equally divided among the several Sch. Dist. of Highland Twp. and transferred to same.

It is also ordered that the balance of \$285.75 in Rhoda Bond & Interest fund be equally divided among the several Sch. Dist. of Rhoda Twp. and transferred to same.
