WHEREAS. the State Highway Commission has never approved the proposed change set forth in said resolution : and

WHEREAS, other petitions have been submitted to the said Board of County Com- missioners requestion that said Highway System be changed in a differnt was from that contained in said resolution, and said Board having duly considered the matter on the proposed changes, and deeming it advisable and necessary, that certain changes be made in the said Highway System as officially established by the Board of County Com- missioners on August 5, 1919, now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, That the resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Charles Mix County, Suth Dakota passed on September 5, 1922, making certain changed in the Highway System of Charles Mix Gunty, South Dakota, subject to the approval of the State Highway Commission, be and the same is hereby revoked and cancelled and for naught : and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the following described highways be abanded and discontinued as a part of the Highway System of Charles Mix County, South Dakota, to- wit :

The highway on the north side of sections 9, 10 and 11, and between sections 11 and 12, and 13 and 14, all in Township 100 north of Range 70, W.


