

The minutes of the last prior meeting were approved as written.

At the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M. the following resolution was offered by Beltman:

RESOLUTION FOR THE ADOPTION OF A SUPPLEMENTARY BUDGET FOR CHARLES MIX COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA FOR THE YEAR OF 1932.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Charles Mix County South Dakota did heretofore on the 4th day of October 1932, make and file in the office of the County Auditor of said county a supplementary budget to compensate for anticipated deficiencies in the County Poor fund and the Custer Sanitorium Fund, for the year of 1932, containing therein the facts, matters and items obtainable to said Board, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 95 of the 1929 Session Laws of the State of South Dakota, and,

WHEREAS, said Board did heretofore, cause said supplementary budget to be published as a part of the proceedings in the three official news papers of the county, at least ten days prior to the date of hearing. In this notice the time fixed for hearing was at 10:00 A.M. of November 1st, 1932, and at said hearing no one appearing to object to said proposed appropriation, and the Board being satisfied that the same should be adopted as originally filed and published, it is

THEREFORE HEREBY RESOLVED, that the said proposed supplementary budget as originally filed and published, with the appropriations contained therein be and the same is hereby approved and adopted as the supplementary budget of appropriations and expenditures for and during the fiscal year of 1932 for Charles Mix County, South Dakota.

RESOLUTION FOR THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS



A compromise settlement of interest in full on the Chris Fredrick personal tax in the Town of Ravinia for the years of 1920, 1921 and 1922. In this instance the principal of the tax had been paid in full on a prior date and the interest was compromised upon the receipt of \$10.00 therefor.


