911 Telecommunicators SD Retirement Classification Resolution
BE IT RESOLVED that the Charles Mix County Board of Commissioners adopts the following Resolution supporting the classification of Charles Mix/Douglas 911 Telecommunicators as Class B Members of the South Dakota Retirement System.

WHEREAS, a 911 telecommunicator is defined in SDCL 34-45-22 as any employee of the state, or any political subdivision thereof, whose primary full-time or part-time duties are receiving, processing, and transmitting public safety information received through a 911 emergency reporting system as defined in SDCL 34-45-1; and

WHEREAS, the daily duties of a telecommunicator can be demanding, stressful, and emotionally exhausting; and

WHEREAS, low unemployment and labor challenges compel new strategies to retain these dedicated public servants; and

WHEREAS, it is the position of the Charles Mix County Commission to classify the Charles Mix/Douglas 911 telecommunicators as Class B members of the South Dakota Retirement System;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Charles Mix County that the Charles Mix County Commission strongly encourages the South Dakota Retirement System Board of Trustees to reclassify the Charles Mix/Douglas 911 telecommunicators as Class B members of the South Dakota Retirement System.


